Problem	Solution
Service-oriented Architecture (SOA) functionalities for DDS are not implemented for the Classic Platform (CP). Therefore, the CP is incompatible with other DDS systems and particularly with the Adaptive Platform (AP) .	The DDS middleware functions Events, Methods, Fields, Discovery, Triggers and Availability can be configured so that they appear as AUTOSAR Sender/Receiver and Client/Server functions for CP applications: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• This enables CP applications to serve as a service to a client running on an AP or vice versa.• The same client/server paradigm also applies to non-AUTOSAR systems

DDS SOA functionality enables compatibility with all other DDS system, particularly AP
